

Memo to Magnolia Manor Park supporters:

**Save the Date -- Wed Nov 5, 6:30 – 8 pm.** The Parks Department is holding a public meeting to get your input/suggestions for Magnolia Manor Park. **Location: Magnolia Community Center, 2550 34<sup>th</sup> Ave W.**

The City Council has approved the Opportunity Fund proposal from Friends of Magnolia Manor Park Steering Committee as the third phase in implementing the master plan concept for Magnolia Manor Park.



The planning process for the development of Magnolia Manor Park began in 2010 and involved extensive public input and meetings and reflects the interests and concerns from surrounding neighbors. Two phases of the plan have already been implemented – the off leash area and the P-Patch.

While the ‘missing piece’ is small it is critical to transforming the park into an integrated functional whole rather than the isolated parts that exists today. The additional open space and connecting path greatly increases the utility of this valuable space for public use. The public benefit from opening this remaining part is tremendous and is very definitely part of the master plan.

Please voice your suggestions on what you would like to see the ‘missing piece look like, how the north side of the park should be renovated, and upgrades for the P-Patch and off leash areas are being sought.
